# ya no means "no longer", e.g.: Ya no es lo que ha sido - It is no longer now what it has been; ya no me duele - it doesn't hurt anymore; ya no es así - it's no longer like that

# todavía no means "not yet", e.g.: todavía no lo he recibido - I haven't got it yet; todavía no lo ha encontrado - he still has not found it
