ya no means "no longer", e.g.: *Ya no es lo que ha sido* - It is no longer now what it has been; *ya no me duele* - it doesn't hurt anymore; *ya no es así* - it's no longer like that

todavía no means "not yet", e.g.: *todavía no lo he recibido* - I haven't got it yet; *todavía no lo ha encontrado* - he still has not found it
